About the Foundations Fees Schedule

This document provides a consolidated view of all amounts deducted from donations made to the charitable foundations that Benevity works with ("Foundations"). These deductions do not reduce the donation amount reflected on any donation documentation issued to donors. Please note that all amounts and fees indicated in this document may be updated periodically. If a Benevity client's agreement rates differ from the rates indicated in this document, the rates in the master agreement will supersede the ones noted in this document.

Cause Support Fee

Upon the applicable Foundation obtaining beneficial ownership of any donations, it will deduct a portion to cover administrative and operating expenses to conduct its charitable operations (such deduction, the "**Cause Support Fee**"). For the avoidance of doubt and additional clarity, the Cause Support Fee is donated to and legally owned by the applicable Foundation, regardless of whether it is paid to an intermediary as an agent for the Foundation or otherwise.

Note: The Cause Support Fee Caps do not apply to matching transactions or gift of securities donations. The Cause Support Fee Cap also does not apply to Community Investment products. This maximum deduction from each donation fee change does not apply to clients existing prior to October 1, 2023.

* The Cause Support Fee may be different based on a Benevity client's master agreement; the Cause Support Fee for Online Giving Foundation in India is 5.9% due to unique local legislation.

** The maximum deduction from each donation in the local currency is CAD \$500, EUR €500, GBP £500, NZD \$500, AUD \$500, SGD \$500, ILS ₪1,500, PLN zł1,600, SEK 4,500kr, ZAR \$7,500, INR ₹35,000, JPY ¥60,000

Merchant Fees

When a donation is made using credit card, Apple Pay or PayPal, a payment processing fee is deducted from the donation to cover "merchant account" or "interchange" fees that are charged by third-party payment processors to the Foundations (the "**Merchant Fees**"). Such Merchant Fees may be split between the payment processor and the applicable Foundation.

Note: All credit and debit card payment processing fees also apply to Apple Pay.

* The PayPal fixed fee applies to the currency being donated in. The fees are as follows: GBP = £0.20, CAD = \$0.30, AUD = \$0.30, CHF = CHF0.55, EUR = €0.35, ILS = ₪1.20, JPY = ¥40, PLN = 1.35 zł, SEK = 3.23 kr, SGD = \$0.50, USD = \$0.30

Foreign Exchange Transaction (FX) Fees

A foreign currency exchange may be undertaken at the sole discretion of the applicable Foundation or Benevity in order to process the donation and/or disbursement. In such case, a foreign exchange markup may be applied on the currency exchange from one currency to another. The foreign exchange markup may be split between the applicable Foundation and its banking partner. The foreign exchange (FX) occurs after all the funds destined to a Cause¹ are aggregated for disbursement. This means that the currency exchange happens at the time of disbursement.

Note: Due to economic conditions and/or currency liquidity, some currencies may have higher FX fees.

¹ Note that "Cause" as used herein has the same meaning as Recipient Organization (as defined in the Software and Service Information) and "Cause" (as defined in the Causes Terms of Use and End User Terms of Use).

Manual Check Fee

When a recipient Cause has not enabled an electronic method for payment, the funds it receives are subject to a manual processing fee. The fee applies only after a Cause has received two checks, in order to give it time to set up an electronic disbursement payment option.

Note: Checks will not typically be distributed to a Cause outside of the U.S. or Canada; such Cause outside of the U.S. or Canada will typically need to sign up for electronic payment via the Benevity Causes Portal in order to receive Donation Funds.

Manual Check Threshold

Donations across the entire Benevity Platform (from all users, including all of Benevity's clients) which recommend a Cause that has not signed up for electronic payment via the Benevity Causes Portal must equal at least \$100 (CAD or USD, as applicable) (the "**Manual Check Threshold**") before a check will be sent to such Cause. However, amounts recommended for Causes that are below the Manual Check Threshold will be "swept" annually if the amount being disbursed is at least \$20 (CAD or USD, as applicable), resulting in a distribution of such amounts by check approximately once every twelve months. If, at the time of an annual "sweep", all amounts recommended for a Cause are below \$20 (CAD or USD, as applicable) and such Cause has not signed up for electronic payment via the Benevity Causes Portal, then the related donor advice may be rejected and the applicable user(s) may be given an opportunity to provide alternate donor advice for another Cause.

Disbursement Thresholds and Limits

Due to operational and/or security related considerations, the Foundations and/or Benevity Platform may impose minimum donation or disbursement thresholds and/or maximum donation or disbursement limits in certain circumstances for a donation or disbursement to be processed.
